Tickets £3.50 (see any of the committee or pay at the door).



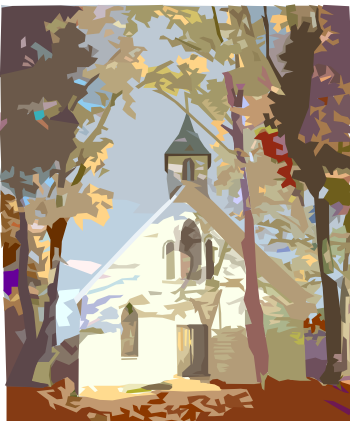
