Excerpt from Prayer Diary 18th March

“After praying together, we started the patrol along the High Street and soon met up with a soldier who was home on leave from Syria for a few weeks. He had been a rebel teenager and decided to turn his life around and join the army. He related that he had been on the front-line recently and was humbled by the gratitude of the Syrian people as he shared food and water with them. He had tried to help a young boy who was caught in the cross fire but he was unable to save him. He eventually returned the body of the boy to his family. An amazing young man, in his 20’s who had seen the devastating effects of war, he will be returning to Syria soon. We offered to pray for him and encouraged him, hugged him and shook his hand. “

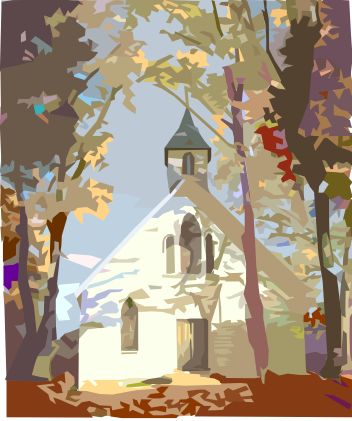
