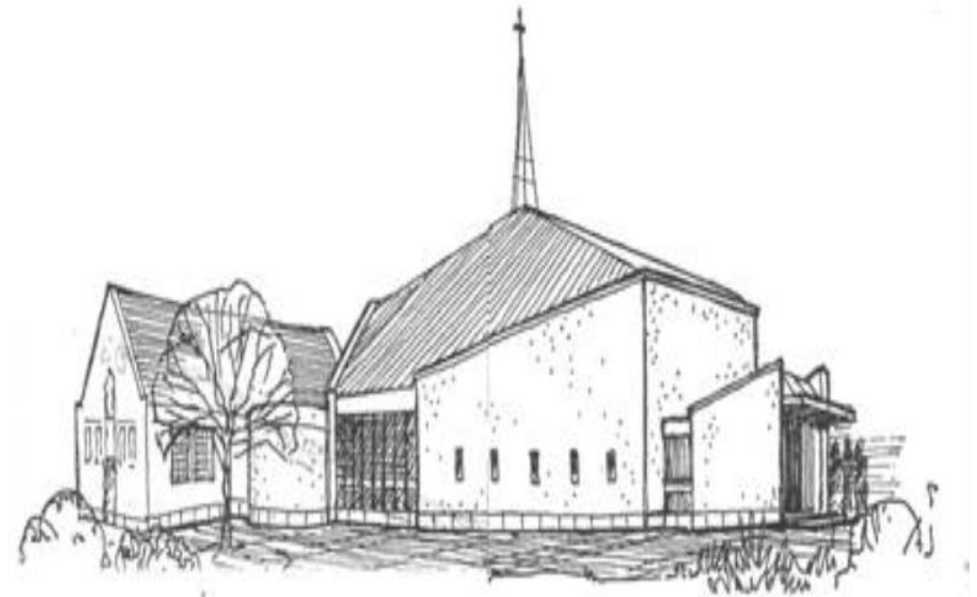

Money Matters

During lockdown, income became more important than ever as there was a reliance on our cash flow to pay our bills.

The 2020 accounts demonstrated the loyalty of our members as we showed a marginal increase in income from the year before which we are thankful for.

As we approach another year end, we hope that this loyalty is repeated and, to assist with this we would ask, if you have not already done so, that you give consideration to moving away from Free Will Offering and Open Plate donations in favour of Bank Standing Orders.

Standing Orders & Direct Debit are what most of us are now familiar with as our home finance spend is usually linked with some of these, so it makes sense to incorporate our commitment to God's work here at Bennochty within our regular Standing Order payments.

Whilst giving consideration to Standing Orders, please also consider completing a Gift Aid declaration form which, if you pay income tax equal to or higher than your amount given to the Church, you are effectively increasing your offering (current 25p for every £1) at no additional cost to you, as we will claim this back from HMRC.

Both the Standing Order and Gift Aid forms are enclosed in the intimations.
